



## Flight Path Training Rebate for Ground School and Written Exam

### Flight Path REBATE requirements, eligibility, terms and conditions.

- The Rebate will be publicized on the FP website, Facebook pages, and other types of event advertising flyers, etc at the discretion of Flight Path.
- Flight Path clearly states the requirements for applying for a Rebate in website information and other related materials. Requirements include:
  - Students must be 14-18 years old.
  - Students must be currently enrolled in a Michigan school or home school and can show documentation..
  - Students must have attended a FLIGHT NIGHT.
  - Students must fill out and submit the Rebate application form on the website
  - Students must provide their name, address, age, grade level, and documentation of school attending or home school.
  - Students must provide a transcript of their grades for the current and previous year.
  - Students must write a meaningful essay explaining their desire to become a pilot and qualify for the Rebate.
  - Students must provide one recommendation letter from a teacher, instructor, coach, pastor, or employer.
  - Student must attest that he/she meets the FAA medical requirements for a Private Pilot. A link to the [FAA Medical Requirements](#) is listed in the Rebate information.
  - Students must be in good standing with their school and community.
  - Students must provide a list of their previous aviation activities.
- Flight Path Training Rebates shall be offered to students meeting the above stated requirements for application.
- Flight Path shall, in consideration of the requirements above, remain unbiased in determining the eligibility of applicants.
- Flight Path Training Rebates shall be offered to students of any race, color, national origin, and ethnic origin.
- Flight Path shall exhibit non-bias in the selection of Rebate recipients
  - Flight Path Training Rebates shall be offered to students of any race, color, national origin, and ethnic origin.
  - The Flight Path Board of Directors at its sole discretion shall select recipients of the Rebate.
  - Applicants must meet all of the eligibility requirements above, and provide all requested information.
  - Applicants must not be related to a disqualified person per IRS section 4946(a)(1).
  - Applicants must not be a previous recipient.
  - The Flight Path Board of Directors shall review each applicant's academic performance/grades, aviation essay, recommendation letter(s), and performance at the Flight Night program.
  - Upon review of all applicants' information and potential additional discussion with applicants, the Board shall determine which two applicants have the most knowledge, skill, desire, and promise to successfully achieve their private pilot's license. The Board shall deliberate until a unanimous decision is reached.
  - Flight Path shall maintain records of all Rebate applications, applicant information, and communications with applicants according to applicable laws.

- Follow-up after selection of Rebate recipients
  - A designated member of the Board shall contact the Rebate recipients to inform them of their Rebate award, and also inform them of the terms of the Rebate disbursement (below).
  - Flight Path shall provide the recipient with a Rebate promissory document worth \$500, redeemable by Flight Path upon completion of pilot Ground School and completion of the pilot's Written Exam.
  - Flight Path shall also provide the recipient with suggested resources for Ground School, and information about where the private pilot's Written Exam may be taken.
  - Rebate recipients must agree to allow Flight Path to use their name and image on the Flight Path website, Facebook page, and other Flight Path communications and promotions.
  - When the recipient provides Flight Path with written evidence of the completion of Ground School and a receipt for the cost, Flight Path shall reimburse the recipient for Ground School costs, not to exceed \$500.
  - When the recipient provides Flight Path with written evidence of the completion of the private pilot's Written Exam and a receipt for the cost, Flight Path shall reimburse the recipient the amount remaining from the \$500 Rebate, less the previous Ground School Rebate disbursement.
  - Maximum Rebate amount for each recipient is \$500.
  - The Rebate must be used within 12 months of award to recipient.
  - Flight Path shall pay the Rebates within 30 days of receipt of Ground School and Written Exam completion documentation from recipients.
  - Flight Path shall maintain records of Rebate recipients, recipient information, and Rebate disbursements according to applicable laws.
  
- Additional Flight Path responsibilities
  - Flight Path shall take reasonable steps to ensure the Rebates are used specifically for pilot Ground School and the private pilot's Written Exam.
  - The Flight Path Board of Directors understands the skills and knowledge required to complete Ground School and the private pilot's Written Exam. In some cases student recipients may not be able to achieve the minimum level of performance required to attain these aviation credentials. In this case Flight Path sees the Rebates as an investment in assisting the student to make another attempt or to form an alternative career plan.
  - Flight Path reserves the right to change or cancel the Rebate program at any time at its sole discretion.
